

Procedure for Written Test / Interview for PhD Admissions in CSRE – December 2018

Candidates appearing for admission to PhD in Geoinformatics and Natural Resources Engineering of Centre of Studies in Resources Engineering (CSRE), IIT Bombay may report to the Centre by 9 AM on 6 December 2018 and assemble in the 1st floor Seminar Hall. The candidates will be briefed about the procedure by the Faculty Coordinator, PhD Admissions for 2018-2019 academic year and the Head of CSRE. The written test will commence at 10 AM and the duration of the test is one hour, i.e., 10 AM – 11 AM. **The written test for each candidate is based on the PhD topic chosen by the candidate.** The full list of topics offered by CSRE faculty members is already displayed on CSRE website <https://www.csre.iitb.ac.in> and while answering the test, the candidate should choose the questions pertaining to his/her topic of interest and indicate the same on the answer book. The cut-off score for selection for general category candidates is 50%, and the same will be proportionally adjusted for OBC/NC, PwD and SC/ST category candidates.

The list of candidates who cleared the written test will be displayed around 1 PM and the interviews for those candidates will commence at 2.30 PM. THE WRITTEN TEST SCORES ARE USED ONLY FOR SCREENING PURPOSE AND NOT CARRIED FORWARD INTO THE INTERVIEWS. Selection of candidates for admission is based entirely on the interview performance of the candidates who cleared the written test. The cut-off score for selection in the interviews is 50% for general category students, and the same will be proportionally adjusted for OBC/NC, PwD and SC/ST category candidates.

The written test will NOT be rescheduled under any circumstances, for any candidate, even if there is a clash of timings for two or more Departments / Centres. Among the candidates who cleared the written test, the sequence of interviews can be adjusted to suit the departure schedule of those who have early flights / trains to catch.
