
Message from The Head, SJMSOM

1. At least one of the following criteria must be met:
 - i) B.E/B.Tech or equivalent degree with 60% marks/6.5 CPI (55% marks/6.0 CPI for SC/ST) and at least two years of work experience and qualified in GATE/UGC-NET (Lectureship)/UGC-JRF/CSIR-NET (Lectureship)/CSIR-JRF or having CAT/GMAT/GRE score within the last five years.
 - ii) Master of Management/ME/M.Tech./M.Pharma/M. Phil/2 years MBA or 2 years PG Diploma in Management from any institute recognized by a Government body (AICTE/UGC/AIU) with 60% marks/6.5 CPI (55% marks/6.0 CPI for SC/ST).
 - iii) M.Sc./M.A/M.Com/LLM/MCA or equivalent degree with 60% marks/6.5 CPI (55% marks/6.0 CPI for SC/ST) at post graduation level and qualified in GATE/UGC-NET (Lectureship)/UGC-JRF/CSIR-NET (Lectureship)/CSIR-JRF, or having CAT/GMAT/GRE taken within the last five years.
 - iv) CA with 60% marks/6.5 CPI (55% marks/6.0 CPI for SC/ST) in the preceding degree.
2. Applicants, who clear eligibility requirement, are required to go through a two stage admission process (Written Test in Stage 1 and Interview in Stage 2), where 2nd stage is only for those who clear the 1st stage. Written Test would be mandatory for all and shortlisted candidates based on written test have to appear for the Interview. **(Reporting Time : 8.30am, Written Test Time: 9.00am, Interview: Afternoon, Venue SJMSOM Office, Ground Floor)**
3. External (EX) candidates are required to provide 'Grant of Leave' absence from their duty, for a period of one year from a Competent Authority of their organization. This is to be made available at the time of interview for admission to the Ph.D. programme. Such candidates are required to give one reputable name for the role of a Supervisor from their company/Organisation (a senior functionary, preferably Ph. D). Such candidates have to attend all classes as per the schedule of the School so as to fulfill all academic requirements of the Ph.D. programme.

4. It must be noted that as per the rules of IIT Bombay, all Self Financed (SF) candidates have to come daily and sign regularly.
5. College Teacher (CT) category students also have to submit leave of absence from duty from their Registrar/Administrative office/Competent Authority and have to sign the attendance register every day. Attending classes for all the registered courses will be mandatory.

At the time of applying to SJMSOM, candidates must also submit either a sample of their recently published writings on a relevant topic or a research proposal (1500 words) on a topic of their interest in place of Statement of Purpose. The proposal must contain: a) problem identification, b) brief review of literature, and c) proposed methodology.
