Only those candidates who are under SC/ST/PwD category and have called for Test/Interview under **Teaching Assistantship** will be paid to and fro Second class non A/c fare by the shortest railway route from their place of residence to the Institute. For this purpose, they have to produce onward railway ticket/photocopy of the return ticket in support of their claims. The concerned candidate has to fill only ONE TA claim form even if he/she has to attended more than one Written Test and/or Interview in different Departments/ Centres/ Schools/ IDPs of the Institution.

Candidates with First class or 60% marks (55% for SC/ST/PwD) in M.Sc./B.E./B.Tech. or equivalent, applied for Ph.D. Programme under "Teaching/Research Assistantship" category MUST HAVE valid GATE score or CSIR/UGC/NBHM research fellowships, failing which, they are not eligible for "Teaching/Research Assistantship" of the Institute.

Candidate will be required to produce at the time of Written Test and/or Interview the following certificates in original for verification.

- * Date of Birth Certificate/10th class leaving certificate.
- * Mark-sheets of the qualifying examination.

- * Final year thesis/dissertation/report/publication
