## IIT Bombay Launches Women-Only Certificate Course on Generative AI for Business

Mumbai, August 18, 2025 — IIT Bombay's Desai Sethi School of Entrepreneurship (DSSE) proudly announces a women-only, beginner-level course titled "GenAl for Business: A Hands-On Introduction", exclusively designed to empower women professionals, entrepreneurs, and managers with practical skills in Generative Al. The course will be conducted online from September 11 to 13, 2025.

This **special edition, women-exclusive program** is a unique opportunity for participants to explore the fast-evolving world of GenAl in a supportive, collaborative learning environment. Tailored for women who are new to Al or curious about its applications, the course demystifies GenAl tools and guides participants on how to use them effectively in their day-to-day work and broader business functions.

The course will run over three days from September 11 to 13, 2025, with evening sessions on Thursday and Friday (5 PM to 8 PM) and a morning session on Saturday (10 AM to 1 PM). It will be conducted fully online and coordinated by Dr. Lina Sonne Vyas, Associate Professor at the Desai Sethi School of Entrepreneurship, IIT Bombay. The Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, set up in 1958 as the second IIT, is recognised worldwide as a leader in the field of science and engineering education and research. The Institute was granted the status of 'Institution of Eminence' by the Ministry of Education (the then Ministry of Human Resources Development) on July 9, 2018.
